<p>In December 2015, the management of the National Tobacco Control Program was transferred from the Health Promotion and Communication Service (HPCS) to the Disease Prevention and Control Bureau (DPCB) by virtue of Department Order 2015-0270. In addition, four (4) full time staff were hired to implement the Bloomberg Initiative Project RIO-401B. Some departments of the DOH assign staff from their unit to work on tobacco control based on demand. NTCCO activities were financed from the grant provided by the International Union Against Tuberculosis and Lung Disease (The Union) with counterpart funds from the DPCB.</p> <p>The DOH has developed its second National Tobacco Control Strategy document for 2017-2022. It summarizes the targets and approaches to reduce tobacco-related burden on non-communicable diseases as well as address the remaining challenges from the first NTCS in 2011-2016. The document details the following nine priority areas for action: protecting public health policies from tobacco industry interference; eliminating remaining tobacco advertising, promotion, and sponsorship; reducing affordability and accessibility of tobacco products; implementing stronger measures to protect the public from exposure to tobacco smoke; strengthening surveillance data; levelling up the DOH Red Orchid Award; strengthening mass media campaign and other communication strategies to sustain public awareness; institutionalizing tobacco control; and regulating tobacco products and strengthening tobacco cessation.</p> <p>At the sub-national levels, Regional Tobacco Control Networks headed by the non-communicable diseases (NCD) coordinators of the Regional Health Offices coordinated and implemented tobacco control activities in their respective regions.</p>

The Civil Service Commission (CSC) and the Department of Health (DOH) issued the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2010-01 dated June 26, 2010 entitled "Protection of the Bureaucracy Against Tobacco Industry Interference," which is an administrative measure intended to implement Article 5.3 of the WHO FCTC.

C124. Please provide a brief description of the progress made in implementing Article 5.3 in the past two years or since submission of your last report.

The CSC, the DOH, and non-governmental institutions involved in the tobacco control policies are at the forefront in conducting orientations on the JMC to government officials and employees, through the Accountability Seminar on Tobacco Industry Interference (ASTII). From 2016 to 2017, all local government units (LGUs) were capacitated relative to the implementation of Article 5.3; as well as forty eight (48) national government agencies. Further, Knowledge products on countering tobacco industry interference (i.e. modules, IEC materials) were developed and were used by different agencies such as the Office of the President. There were also coordination meetings among members of NTCC Article 5.3 where strategic plans and programs were discussed. Complaints relative to possible violation of Article 5.3 from 2016-2017 were reported and filed before the Office of the Ombudsman for appropriate legal action. The CSC and the DOH are actively coordinating with agencies whenever the latter seek legal advice in addressing challenges relative to tobacco industry interference.

The Philippines have also provided technical assistance on Article 5.3 during the South-South and Triangular Cooperation held in Brazil last May 2017.

During the Asean Conference on Civil Service Matters, the Philippines presented the JMC 2010-01 and Article 5.3 among Asean member states. Also, CSC attended as member of delegates to the COP7 and presented the JMC 2010-01 as best practice in implementing Article 5.3 in the Philippines during the side meeting of the conference.

Since the passage of RA 10351 or the Sin Tax Bill, the Department of Health (DOH) had received sin tax incremental revenues earmarked for health from the excise tax on alcohol and tobacco products. The DOH budget increased by almost three-fold, from Php 53 billion in 2013 to Php 148 billion in 2017. Forty percent or Php 58.9 billion of the 2017 health budget is contributed by the Sin Tax.

The national law on Republic Act 9211 or the Tobacco Regulations Act provides a ban on selected public places, transport facilities, access restriction to minors, ban on advertising and promotions as well as printed health warnings. The law also allows for designated smoking areas within indoor workplaces and public places. The passage of the Graphic Health Warning law had recently required the use of pictures in cigarettes packs to warn consumers on the harmful effects of tobacco use.

Sub-national laws include ordinances issued by provinces, cities or municipalities. These are drafted by the local legislative council and implemented at localities administered either by the Provincial Governors, City/ Municipal Mayors and Barangay Captains. Local laws on tobacco control may be more stringent than the national law in view of the autonomy provided to local government units by the Local Government Code of 1991.

Administrative or Executive Orders include the prohibition of smoking in government facilities, schools and public conveyances issued by the office of Civil Service Commission, Department of Education and Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board, respectively. Last May 2017, Philippine President Rodrigo Duterte signed Executive Order no. 26 or the Providing for the Establishment of Smoke-free Environments in Public and Enclosed Places.

Republic Act 9211 mandates the Inter-agency Committee on Tobacco as its implementing arm, provided with exclusive power to administer and implement provisions of the law. The Committee is headed by the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) as Chairperson and the Department of Health (DOH) as Co-Chairperson. Members include the Department of Agriculture, Department of Justice, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Department of Science and Technology, Department of Education, National Tobacco Administration, representative from the Tobacco Industry and a Non-government Organization. The Monitoring and Enforcement Guideline (MEG) of RA 9211 details the designation and functions of pilot agencies in the implementation of the law as well as the procedures in the filing of complaints, investigation and reporting. Violations have corresponding penalties under the law.

At the sub-national level, the Local Government Units (LGUs) may assign or deputize a specific task force to enforce the ordinance on tobacco control. The composition of the task force differs from each LGU, and may include but not be limited to the City/ Municipal Departments such as the City/ Municipal Health Office or City/ Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office, the Local Police Force, Sanitary Inspectors or Traffic Enforcers. Local Tobacco Control Councils may be created to serve as the implementation arm of the LGU. Most of the local enforcers at the sub-national level are authorized to issue citation tickets for violation of their local ordinances. Similarly, violations have corresponding penalties.

Under administrative and executive order, enforcement is assigned to a specific office within the agency, tasked to regulate or implement the policy. Monitoring and enforcement guidelines are issued to set out the procedures.

C227a. Banning tobacco smoking in indoor workplaces

For private indoor workplaces, partial ban to tobacco smoking is enforced. The enforcement of a no smoking policy is highly depended on the individual policies or health programs enforced by each company.

C227b. Banning tobacco smoking in public transport

Tobacco smoking is prohibited in all public conveyances including airplanes, buses, taxis, jeepney and tricycles. Not included in the ban are ferries and private motor vehicles.

C227c. Banning tobacco smoking in indoor public places

Government buildings, health care facilities, as well as educational institutions and universities are prohibited from smoking tobacco. These prohibitions are covered by the policies from the Department of Health and Department of Education. However, shopping malls, pubs and bars, nightclubs, and restaurants only have partial banks. Policies depend on the company and compliance to city/ municipal ordinances.

In 2017, Philippine President Rodrigo Duterte signed the Executive Order no. 26 or "Providing for the Establishment of Smoke-free Environments in Public and Enclosed Places." It provided a framework which encourages local government units to implement smoke-free policies. The order prohibits smoking within enclosed public places and public conveyances. Selling, distributing or purchasing tobacco products to and from minors is also deemed unlawful. Minors are not allowed to smoke, sell or buy cigarettes or any other tobacco products. The order also makes it unlawful for anyone to order a minor to use, light up, buy, sell, distribute, deliver, advertise or promote tobacco products, a practice which is very common especially in rural areas.

At the sub-national level, there is an increasing number of Local Government Units with local ordinances on 100% smoke free environments. Efforts are being made to ensure that local ordinances are consistent with FCTC provisions. The implementation of the Red Orchid Award (ROA) served as an incentive for LGUs to pursue a 100% smoke free environment in their localities. Local ordinances consistent with the FCTC guidelines were made criteria for selection of the winning LGUs in the ROA. The DOH was able to identify LGUs with good practices on 100% smoke free environment through the ROA. As a result, a network of LGUs leading in the implementation of 100% smoke free environment was organized through the Smoke Free Cities Asean Network (SCAN).

The Graphic Health Warning Law (GHW) in the Philippines was passed in August 2014. The first set of 12 GHW templates was published in March 3, 2015. A Graphic Health Warning Implementing Rules and Regulations was finalized in November 2015 and was published in February 11, 2016. By March 4, 2016, all tobacco product manufacturers are required to adopt the GHW templates in the packaging and labeling of their tobacco products.

Since November 2016, all retail stores are required to have displayed tobacco products with GHWs.

The 2nd set of the Graphic Health Warnings was published on September 8, 2017 in a major broadsheet.

Another measure is the institutionalization of the Electronic Official Registry Book (e-ORB) on tobacco products which is an automated facility that allows excise taxpayers to electronically submit the ORBs for monitoring and reconciliation purposes with the end view of uncovering possible discrepancies on declarations of removals of cigarette manufacturers. In 2017, Executive order on smoke-free environments in public and enclosed places was signed by President Rodrigo Duterte. It encourages local government units to pass ordinances that will promote 100% smoke-free environment. Under EO 26, the selling, distributing or purchasing tobacco products to and from minors is deemed unlawful.

Sections 7 to 12 of the Republic Act of 9211 (Tobacco Regulation Act of 2003) on Access Restrictions has prohibited the sale and distribution of tobacco products to minors, purchase of tobacco products from a minor, sale of tobacco products by a minor and for a minor to smoke tobacco products. Moreover, sale of tobacco products is prohibited within 100 meters of school perimeters as well as sale to minors by means of a vending machine or any self-service facility. The law also requires warning to minors about unlawful sale or distribution to minors of tobacco products at points of sale and need for age verification during purchase.

The Department of Education has issued policies to address sales of cigarettes to and by minors within the school such as school premises, school canteens and in the implementation of school activities. Policies are: Operating Guidelines on Canteen Management, 100% Smoke Free Environment, adoption and observance of related provisions of RA 9211 as well as the adoption and implementation of the Joint Memorandum Circular on Protecting the Bureaucracy Against Tobacco Industry Interference (Article 5.3).

The Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) through their Balik Eskwela (Back to School) program conducts daily inspection of stores for display of tobacco products and warning to minors, within the 100% meter school perimeters in Metropolitan Manila. To date, 2,183 stationary stores and 780 ambulant vendors had been monitored by the MMDA for compliance to access restriction laws.

The Department of Education (DepEd) has initiated the development of a Comprehensive Policy and Guidelines on Tobacco Control to address not only the problem of smoking in schools and Department premises but also address tobacco industry interference in DepEd implementation policies in the guise of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). The DepEd policy includes education and information on harmful effects of tobacco use and exposure to second hand smoke as well as tobacco industry interference tactics; and guidelines to access effective cessation intervention services. It also includes guidelines on the enforcement of absolute smoking bans, access restrictions to minors, ban on tobacco outdoor advertisements, promotion and sponsorship as well as school donations received through the CSR activities of tobacco companies.

Starting FY 2015 to 2017, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), through the Bureau of Workers with Special Concerns (BWSC) received P10.0M yearly allocation or a total of P30.0M under RA 10531 (Sin Tax Reform Law) Fund to support economically viable alternative activities for displaced workers in the tobacco and alcohol industries, which was implemented under DOLE Integrated Livelihood and Emergency Employment Program (DILEEP).

A total of 4,147 tobacco crop grower- beneficiaries were already assisted in the amount of P20,388,054.00 for economically viable alternative projects and emergency employment assistance:

- 2,746 tobacco growers were assisted towards alternative livelihood for a total grant assistance amounting to P13,903,252.00.

Formation and enhancement projects such as water refilling station in the community, rice thresher, corn sheller/husker, farm equipment such as water pump and hoses to irrigate their farms, small tractors and hand tractors, shedder for organic fertilizer production projects, Starter Kits and Nego Karts for vending activities were provided to the farmer-tobacco growers and tobacco leaf traders.

- 1,817 tobacco growers affected by natural calamities were provided with emergency employment assistance in the amount of P6,611,000.00 in Abra, Ilocos Norte, Isabela and Cagayan.

Tobacco farmer/growers affected by natural calamities were provided short-term employment in community-based projects for a minimum of 10 days to a maximum of 30 days and paid the mandated minimum wage.

Spearheaded by the BWSC-DOLE, a Workshop Towards the effective implementation of Articles 17 and 18 of the WHO-FCTC on Tobacco Control last August 22-25, 2017 in Laoag City, Ilocos Norte was conducted. The workshop was participated by representatives from the central and Region 1 agencies of DOH, DA, DAR, DENR, TESDA, FCTAP, DOLE and BWSC. Based on discussions on current status, challenges and issues in the implementation of programs and services relative to Articles 17 and 18, a concrete and doable 2018 Action Plan towards the realization of Articles 17 and 18 of the WHO-FCTC was prepared. In addition, agencies were required to designate their focal and alternate representatives to ensure that planned activities are undertaken by the concerned agency/agencies.

To date, coordination with the final pilot project sites in Ilocos Sur, namely: Barangay Barbar in San Juan and Barangays Aguing and Cadanglaan in Sinit is being undertaken by DOLE and DOH.
