

1 Section 21. Apportionment and allotment. Unless otherwise stated in this Act, amounts
2 appropriated in this Act shall be apportioned and allotted at the direction of the President.

3 Section 22. Amendment. Section 2 of RPPL 5-38, as amended by RPPL 6-15 and RPPL
4 6-26, is further amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 2. Health Facilities Construction, Renovation, and Repairs. The sum of
6 \$3,062,000 is hereby authorized to be appropriated and is appropriated The total sum
7 shall be allocated according to the following schedule and the funds appropriated in (1), (2),
8 (5) and (6) below shall not lapse until September 30, 2002. The funds appropriated in (3)
9 and (4) shall not lapse at end of fiscal year.

21 No. 6-35(5), is further amended to read as follows:
