Sale to and by minors is regulated by the Article 8 of RA Law "On restrictions of tobacco sale, consumption and use", adopted by the National Assembly of Armenia on December 24, 2004.

THE LAW OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA
"On restrictions of tobacco sale, consumption and use"

Adopted by the National Assembly of Armenia on December 24, 2004.

Article 8. Restrictions on Sale of Tobacco Products

1. Sales of tobacco products shall be prohibited:

1) to persons under the age of 18 ;

2) by persons under the age of 18;

3) in opened packs or by pieces;

4) without direct participation of the seller (through all forms of self-service, including via vending machines, other electronic or mechanical devices), with the exception of the places, where the entrance of minors is prohibited by legislation of the Republic of Armenia;

2. Near the cash desks or their adjacent territories at all sale points of tobacco products in a visible place the following warnings shall be compulsory exhibited:

1) "Tobacco products shall not be sold to persons under the age of 18";

2) warning of the authorized body on the negative impact of tobacco on human health.

3. When selling tobacco products, all persons, engaged in trade of tobacco products, are obliged not to sell cigarettes to those buyers appearing under the age of 18. If the buyer presents an identification document (passport, driver's license, or military service identity card), only in this case the person engaged in realization of tobacco products is allowed to sell tobacco.
