Almost a quarter of the respondents were exposed to tobacco smoke at home (23.0%), and roughly a half of these are non-smokers. A startling fact is that the highest proportion of those is the youngest group aged 15-24, which includes the adolescents aged 15-18. The exposure to tobacco smoke in this age group (20.4%) is twice as high as in other age categories.

The results from 2012 and 2014 are very similar; no improvement of the situation occurred.

Men are more often exposed to tobacco smoke at a workplace than women. The number of non-smokers exposed to tobacco smoke is decreasing along the increasing level of education by more than a half.

When compared to 2012, there was a decline of non-smokers exposed to tobacco smoke by 5% (19.6% vs. 14.4%). Nonetheless, the high percentage of non-smokers exposed to tobacco smoke in enclosed workplaces demands further clarification.

In the case of cigarettes, the minimum excise duty rate has increased by 12 %, the excise duty rate on fine cut tobacco and other smoking tobacco by 19 % and the tax rate on cigars by 22 %. Moreover, a new tax on raw tobacco corresponding to the excise duty rate on fine cut tobacco was introduced in July 2015. In the coming years, excise tax will be gradually increased according to the legally binding timetable.

Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic:

In May 2014 the Government approved a document which lays down the strategic goals of the national policy in relation to young people for the period 2014-2020, as well as setting out objectives and measures pertaining to the areas of risk behaviour and physical and mental health, including addictive behaviour and addiction. This policy approach is primarily targeted at adolescents and young adults.

The core documents for the area of school-based prevention are the National Strategy for the Primary Prevention of Risk Behaviour for 2013-2018 and the Methodological Recommendations on the Primary Prevention of Risk Behaviour among Children and Young People. The main objective of this strategy is to prevent or reduce risk behaviour among children and adolescents by means of an effective prevention system underpinned by comprehensive synergetic efforts on the part of all the stakeholders.

The Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic yearly financially supports the prevention programs in which smoking prevention is one of the priorities. The programs are aimed at work with pupils, teachers and teacher's education in this field.

All schools have a "prevention methodologist" who is responsible for the smoking prevention activities. Each school implement its preventive programme which includes prevention of tobacco use, as well.

A national system of quality assessment of preventive programs for schools (called a certification procedure) is in place - prevention of tobacco use is a required part of these programs. This system has a practical impact on the above mentioned grant system of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport of the Czech Republic.

There are examples of successful school-based preventive programs such as UNPLUGGED (topic of tobacco use included among other examples of risk behaviour), which has been carried out in many schools of the Czech Republic (confirmed efficacy of the program in prevention of tobacco use).

After a successful test the effectiveness of interventions Unplugged, also in the area of tobacco use among elementary school children, there was in years 2014 - 2015 further development and expansion of this intervention in the Czech Republic managed by the Department of Addictology of Charles University in Prague - the First Faculty of Medicine and General University Hospital in Prague. Courses for teachers from all the regions were organised. At the same time an additional booster intervention for 7th grade of primary school, was created and currently is being evaluated through randomized controlled trial, involving also the area of tobacco use.

Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic:

In 2015 Ministry of Health in close cooperation with other ministries, representatives of professional organizations etc prepared among others above mentioned action plans: the Action plan for the area of tobacco control in the Czech Republic for the period 2015-2018 and Action plan for the formation of an interdisciplinary interdepartmental framework of primary risk behaviour prevention among high-risk groups of children in the Czech Republic, which are related also to the some issues of Article 12 FCTC.

Furthermore, the Ministry of Health financially supported from its funding programs several projects promoting prevention of tobacco use in 2014 - 2015.

For example the Ministry of health supported the National health programme – Health promotion projects:

- 2014 Promoting patient awareness and education of health professionals in the treatment of tobacco dependence, No drink! No smoke! Be cool!, Verification methodology of brief interventions in practice II

- 2015 Promoting patient awareness and education of health professionals in the treatment of tobacco dependence, Smoke-free homes

National Institute of Public Health in Prague /NIPH/ provided:

- Programme for health care professionals to use the methodology of brief interventions – MoH health promotion project; Programme for health care professionals: Certified MoH program for health care professionals focused on the training of early identification, brief intervention and consulting in addictive behaviors, including smoking;

- Courses accredited by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports for teachers: "How not to become an addict";

- Health promotion projects: 2015

The interactive game for school children: How not to become an addict

The interactive game for children in the form of fairy tales "I will not start with you, cigarette"

"No Smoking is a Norm" (program for elementary and secondary schools)

Mosaic for health : interactive program for school children

Ministry of Defence:

In May 2015 Minister of Defence approved decision No. 56/2015 "Primary prevention of risky behaviour of personnel of Ministry of Defence". Among others, training of newly coming personnel in issue of addictions within the obligatory minimum prevention programme is included.

Programs/campaigns:

Center for Tobacco-Dependent of General University Hospital in Prague and Charles University – the first Faculty of Medicine in coordination with Society for tobacco dependence treatment organized every year 2 events for general public (World No Tobacco Day and International Non-smoking Day) with CO measurement and possibility of expert consultations. 6 other seminars (twice a year from 2014) with discussions about smoking cessation took place in therapeutic communities for addiction treatment on illicit drugs.

Two conferences for physicians and nurses are organized every year (since 2006), focusing on tobacco dependence treatment (Tobacco and Health in November and conference for the staff of Centers for Tobacco-Dependent in April).

Since 2012 The Society for Tobacco Dependence Treatment has organised, in the frame of a project with ISNCC (International Society of Nurses in Cancer Care) , 8 one-day workshops and 21 educational seminars for nurses focusing on brief intervention in smoking cessation.

Other educational activities for health professionals in 3.2.8.14.

On the occasion of World No Tobacco Day, the Czech Chamber of Pharmacists prepared a campaign entitled "Smoking Cessation in Pharmacies", which involved free consultations on smoking cessation options provided by pharmacists in selected pharmacies for a period of one week.

Some local events or campaigns focused on education, communication, public awareness related to prevention of tobacco use or exposure to tobacco smoke were organised by some municipalities – members of The National Healthy Cities Network.

For example in December 2015 Brno Office - Healthy City of Brno City Hall in cooperation with the Centre for tobacco dependence treatment at University Hospital Brno-Bohunice second annual campaign focused on the issue of passive smoking. The aim of the campaign was to draw attention to smoking especially negative impact of passive smoking and at the same time help those who want to quit this habit. Through a series of 20 events more than 3,500 visitors at selected shopping centers in Brno were informed about the harmful effects of passive smoking. During the campaign, it was also a survey, in which the public had an opportunity to comment on the issue of smoking in the city.

Czech Coalition against Tobacco offers and carries out primary prevention programs in elementary schools (program "Nekuřátka") and secondary schools (program "Típní to"). Campaigns related to World No Tobacco Days in Prague are organised every year. A program related to non smoking workplace is offered to firms.

There is a continuing implementation of specialized training program for professionals in Addiction science in the Czech Republic, which includes issue of tobacco use and working with users of tobacco, both in terms of prevention and treatment. The curricula and scope of the topic associated with tobacco are harmonising with an international certificate ICCE. The Czech Republic joined the project, the Colombo Plan, and in 2016 is now preparing the pilot testing of the curriculum UPC / UTC and entered into cooperation with universities educating professionals in addictions (ICUDDR).

There is a legally binding obligation for health professionals to conduct a brief intervention consisting of the timely diagnosis of abuse among persons who use tobacco products which is incorporated in the above mentioned Act No. 379/2005 Coll. The brief intervention is mostly offered by physicians and increasingly also by nurses. There are specialised courses in place on prevention of harmful use of addictive substances and treatment of addictions is obligatory for all physicians of all branches as a part of specialization trainings (as mentioned already above). The Society for Treatment of Tobacco Dependence (www.SLZT.CZ) provides continuing education in treatment of tobacco dependence for physicians (CME credits of the Czech medical Chamber, one-day courses), nurses (CME credits of the Czech Association of Nurses, one-day course) and pharmacists (CME credits of the Pharmacist's Chamber, 2-day course). It provides also education and regular update for nurses and physicians of Centres for Tobacco-Dependent, including regular conferences at least twice a year. There is a collaboration of nurses from the General University Hospital in Prague and the Society for Treatment of Tobacco Dependence with International Society of Nurses in Cancer Care (www.isncc.org) which is focused on educating nurses in brief interventions. Most of health professions undergo occasional trainings in treatment of tobacco dependence, but it is not systematic. Trainings include treatment of pregnant, psychiatric, adolescent and other disadvantaged smokers, as well.

In 2015 New Tobacco dependence treatment guidelines Tobacco Guidelines for treatment of tobacco dependence were published in journal of Czech Society of Internal Medicine and Slovak Society of Internal Medicine "Vnitřní lékařství". (Available on-line: <http://www.vnitrnilekarstvi.eu/vnitri-lekarstvi-clanek/doporuceni-pro-lecbu-zavislosti-na-tabaku-52291>).

Intensive treatment is offered in the frame of the Centres for Tobacco-Dependent, based in hospitals mostly at pneumology, cardiology, internal clinics - currently 41 Centres across the country (see <http://www.slzt.cz/centra-lecbu>). They are under supervision of the Society for Treatment of Tobacco Dependence.

In terms of coverage of treatment by public funding, there are two treatment codes covered by the health insurance companies (60 minutes intervention, 30 minutes follow-up visit). The treatment service is free of charge apart from medication for patients. The pharmacotherapy is not reimbursed generally by health insurance companies - only some of them financially support pharmacotherapy for their clients treated in the specialized Centres for Tobacco-Dependent . .

Treatment is also provided by some physicians, pneumologists and other medical specialists. It is not systematic. Treatment can be provided also by addictologists (a new official branch of health professionals in the Czech Republic who focus on prevention and treatment of addictive diseases).

A legislation adopted in 2013 allows to cover a treatment provided by addictologists from health insurance system. In 2015 contracts for the first 7 addictologist outpatient services were negotiated with VZP (Health Insurance Company). These agreements also include the work with users of tobacco. Addictologist services should supplement the existing network of Centres for Tobacco-Dependent in future and could focus on less motivated smokers etc.

Treatment of tobacco dependence is provided also in the Army of the Czech Republic (ACR). In November 2014 Minister of Defence approved Conception of primary prevention of risk behaviour at personnel of Ministry of Defence for the period of 2015 - 2019. Among tasks of conception are also preventive intervention as regards tobacco use.

Czech Pharmacist's Chamber continued to organise program "Smoking Cessation in Pharmacies" in 2014-2015.

A "Quit line" (number 844 600 500) is available for a reduced charge between 11 - 16 hours during working days. However, it is provided by the NGO "Czech Coalition against Tobacco" without any systematic support by the state. Consultants work on volunteer basis.

Project of quit line was prepared also by the Department of Addictology of the First Faculty of Medicine Charles University in Prague General University Hospital in Prague.

Campaigns/projects:

There have not been any national specially designed programmes for specific social groups in the past two years.

Campaigns/projects were rather generally focused. There were some local events, mainly related to World No Tobacco Day, organised by several NGOs every year.

The Department of Addictology of the First Faculty of Medicine Charles University in Prague General University Hospital in Prague stabilised screening and intervention program for pregnant women - users of tobacco.

Several hospitals are active in Health Promoting Hospitals/Smokefree Hospitals Program.

In June 2015, the Czech government approved a Draft Act on the protection of health against the harmful effects of addictive substances. This act will replace the Act No. 379/2005 Coll. Text of the draft act is publicly available online in English and other languages: <http://ec.europa.eu/growth/tools-databases/tris/en/search/?trisaction=search.detail&year=2015&num=331>. The governmental Act was submitted to the Parliament of the Czech Republic and it is being in the legislative process in the Parliament of the Czech Republic - discussed as document No. 508 (in the phase before the third reading in the Chamber of Deputies).
The draft act contains for example:

A significant improvement in prosecuting capabilities was introduced by the act No. 418/2011 Coll. – On Criminal Liability of Legal Persons. This law has substantially changed the basics of criminal liability in the Czech Republic by introducing liability of legal persons for enumerated criminal offences.

An amendment of the Act No. 418/2011 Coll., on Criminal Liability of Legal Persons, has been submitted to the Parliament of the Czech Republic in September 2014. It has been approved by its House of Representatives in March 2016 and is currently being considered by the Senate. The amendment intends to enlarge the scope of crimes for which the legal persons should be liable.
