The cost from premature mortality was Rs. 73,000 crores (US\$ 15.6 billion).  
This study considered three major categories of costs to estimate the total economic burden attributable to tobacco: (1) direct medical cost of treating tobacco related diseases; (2) indirect morbidity costs; and (3) indirect mortality costs of premature deaths due to tobacco use. In all the three components, only the portion of the cost that can be attributed to tobacco use is estimated in the study. To estimate the costs of premature mortality, the study used a human capital approach and estimated the expected value of lost future productivity caused by tobacco attributable premature deaths. All the three components of the costs were estimated separately for males and females aged 35-69 by type of tobacco use, namely, smoked and smokeless tobacco. Apart from estimating the costs at the national level, the study also estimated the costs in thirteen major states of India that accounted for 86 percent of the country's population. These states were selected based on sample size criteria of having at least 2000 households with complete data on morbidity, health care and condition of the aged. Data were taken from a variety of sources, the primary data for estimating the costs of diseases was the unit level data from the 60th round of the National Sample Survey (NSS-2004), namely, "Morbidity, Health Care and the Condition of the Aged". Data for tobacco use prevalence were obtained from the Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS 2009-10). The costs were estimated for 2004 and updated for the year 2011 by using consumer price index.

Under the current 12th Five year plan (2012-17) NTCP is proposed to cover all the states and districts of the country in a phase-wise manner NTCP is implemented through a three tiered structure (i) National Tobacco Control cell (ii) State tobacco control cell & (iii) District tobacco control cell

#### A. National Tobacco Control Cell

The National Tobacco Control Cell (NTCC) under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare is responsible for overall policy formulation, planning, monitoring and evaluation of the different activities envisaged under the programme.

- Establishment of tobacco product testing laboratories.

During the year 2014-15 the tax on cigarettes (for different length segments and slabs) was increased in the range of 12% to 72%. In the year 2015-16, the Central Excise Duty was increased in the range of 15% to 25% across different slabs. However, there was no increase in the excise duty on Bidi.  
Ministry of Health & family Welfare is pursuing with the Ministry of Finance for development of a comprehensive tax policy on tobacco products. The Union Health Minister also wrote to the Union Finance Minister for introduction of Sin Tax on demerit goods like tobacco, alcohol and sugary drinks.
