B123. Please provide a brief explanation of the trend in current smoking prevalence by age group in the past two years or since submission of your last report, if data are available.

The smoking prevalence in the population aged 15 years or more decreased slightly, from 20.9% in 2005/2006 to 20% in 2014. However it should be noted, a reduction of nearly two percentage points of daily smoking prevalence: from 18.7% in 2005/06 to 16.8% in 2014.

The percentage of former smokers increased by almost 6 percentage points in the same period: from 16.1% (2005/2006) to 21.7% (2014).

The percentage of people who never smoked decreased: 62.9% in 2005/2006 to 58.2% in 2014.

The comparison of prevalence rates observed in the last two National Health Surveys (2005/2006 and 2014), by sex, shows a decrease in daily users in males (27.5% to 23.5%) and a small increase (3 percentage points) in daily users in females (10.6% to 10.9%).

The prevalence of "never smokers" reduced almost 5 percentage points, which indicates that the reduction in the prevalence of smoking was achieved mainly by the increasing of the number of people who quit smoking.

The age group 25 to 34 years has the higher prevalence of daily smokers, about 26% in both sexes.

The Law 37/2007 of 14th August, modified by the Law 109/2015 of 26th August, that entered into force on the 1st January 2016, establishes a smoking prohibition in all enclosed public places, schools, health services, work places, airports and public transport. However, there are some exceptions: it is possible to create smoking rooms in restaurants, pubs and bars, bingo and casinos, hotels, prisons, psychiatric hospitals and airports. These smoking rooms must have certain conditions: they should be totally enclosed and signalized, have a ventilation with a negative pressure of a minimum of 5 Pascal, no minors are allowed inside, no food or other services can be offered. In leisure establishments, bingo, betting rooms and casinos it will be possible to create smoking areas of a maximum of 40% of the gambling areas.

Secondary legislation, from Health, Environment and Economy Ministers, needs yet to be published, in order to specify other requirements for these smoking rooms.

However, the smoking areas or smoking rooms already in place on the 1st January 2016, that accomplish with the requirements of the previous tobacco law, can be allowed until 31 December 2020.

Portugal implements a mixed excise system with a minimum specific tax floor and an ad valorem tax. All tobacco products need to be approved by the Customs and Tax Authority before being placed on the market. The tax burden on all tobacco products is annually reviewed and, if necessary, increased. It is not easy to explain with detail all the legal dispositions. Perhaps only the major areas shoul be evaluated in a comparable way across the parties. The criteria to fill in certain areas shoul be more clear in order to raise the comparability of data.
