For example, a sales tax that is applied at the final stage of the distribution process will be calculated on top of those taxes that have previously been levied. If the tax is expressed as an amount then the base of the tax is the volume of the good that is taxed. For example, if a tax is \$5 per 100 cigarettes, the amount of tax is \$5 and the base of the tax is 100 cigarettes.
